

The Heathcote region has long been recognized as one of Australia's pre-eminent locations for ultra premium Shiraz and what sets it apart is the idyllic continental climate and the famous strip of 600 million year old deep red Cambrian soil. These ancient soils impart typically identifiable characteristics of ripe full-flavoured wines, deep purple/black in colour with rich and velvety berry fruit flavours into this wine.

All the indicators of an age worthy shiraz with enough freshness and sweet fruit to be ready to go now, definitely improved over a number of hours in a decanter.

Tasting Notes

Colour: Intense deep red

Bouquet: Powerfully expressive aromas of blackberry, pepper and dried herbs all in concentration.

Palate: The pallet is full of blackberry fruit and spice, great structure with plenty of tannin and balanced with a noticeably vibrant acidity

Food Pairing: Roast Venison with potato gratin

Cellaring: Seven years under ideal storage conditions
