It has penetration and persistence at the same time as impressive elegance."

Tasting Notes

Colour: Bouquet: The nose displays a mix of red and black fruits - red plum, plum and blackcurrant with underlying spice and dried bayleaf. **Palate:** The palate provides layers of fruit ripeness including cherry, plum and cassis. The flavours are well supported by delicately interwoven French oak characters and a dried herb complexity. There is power, yet a structure and balance that results in a wine that has a fine and long finish. **Food Pairing:** Cellaring: Delicious now or cellar until 2035
